Recognition:

Stage of Possible Victim/Current Victim

- Realize there is or could be a problem.
- Determine the nature of the problem.
- How is the problem impacting them?

Program Ideas for GFWC volunteers

- Create awareness campaigns using resources.
- Prepare information on healthy relationships using resources.
- Introduce programs on life skills.

Rescue:

Stages of Possible Victim/Current victim

- Actions to get out of or away from the problem
- Provide connections to law enforcement and phone numbers for hotlines
- Provide emergency supplies and hygiene items.

Program Ideas for GFWC Volunteers

- Support law enforcement efforts and/or programs.
- Support other assistance agencies.
- Make hotlines readily available in secure locations.

Recovery:

Stage of Survivor

- Encourage the survivor to regroup with assistance.
- Build confidence to reestablish stability.
- Enrolls in personal development opportunities.

Program Ideas for GFWC Volunteers

- Volunteer in local shelters.
- Provide information of local therapy projects.
- Assist with clothing and hygiene needs.

Renaissance:

Stage of Survivor

- Steps out in positive direction.
- Integration into creating a new sense of self and personal future.
- Redefines themselves in the context of meaningful relationships.

Program Ideas for GFWC Volunteers

- Locate scholarships available for survivors.
- Present avenues for job training.
- Introduce professional development opportunities available.
